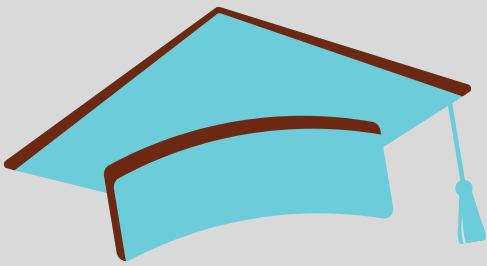

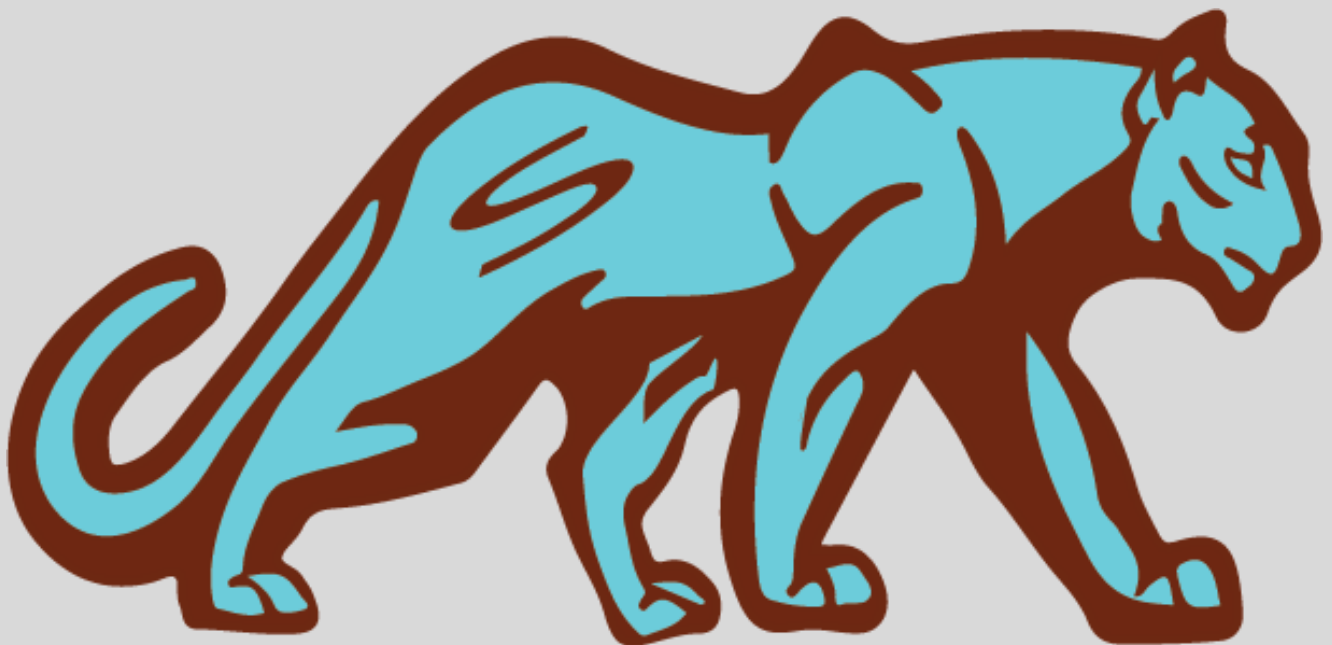

## VA BENEFITS: CERTIFICATION, VERIFICATION, AND ADMISSION

Veterans and others who qualify for veteran's educational assistance have been approved to attend Southeast New Mexico College courses for study. Processing applications and certifications takes from 4 to 5 weeks and should be initiated well in advance of course registration. ### NM LEGISLATIVE LOTTERY SCHOLARSHIP

Recent high school graduate from a NM public or private school and plan to enroll full-time within 16 months of graduating.

### NM OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

Established NM resident and plan to enroll in at least 6 credit hours at a public college or university in NM toward a training certificate or associate degree.

### SOUTHEAST NEW MEXICO COLLEGE BRIDGE

Criteria: NM High School/GED grad

Requirements: NM Resident enrolling full time within 16 months following graduation.

### CHEVRON WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Non-traditional student in the sciences, including engineering, allied health, nursing, and industrial programs.

Requirements: 6 Credit hours

### SOUTHEAST NEW MEXICO COLLEGE RETURNING ADULT

Criteria: Student returning to college after 2 years.

Requirements: Cumulative 2.5 GPA

### CARLSBAD DOWNTOWN LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

At least sophomore status students (28 credits or more) who plan to enroll fulltime and have a minimum 2.5 cumulative college GPA

### CARLSBAD HEIGHTS LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Student Returning to college after 2 years

Requirements: Cumulative 3.0 GPA

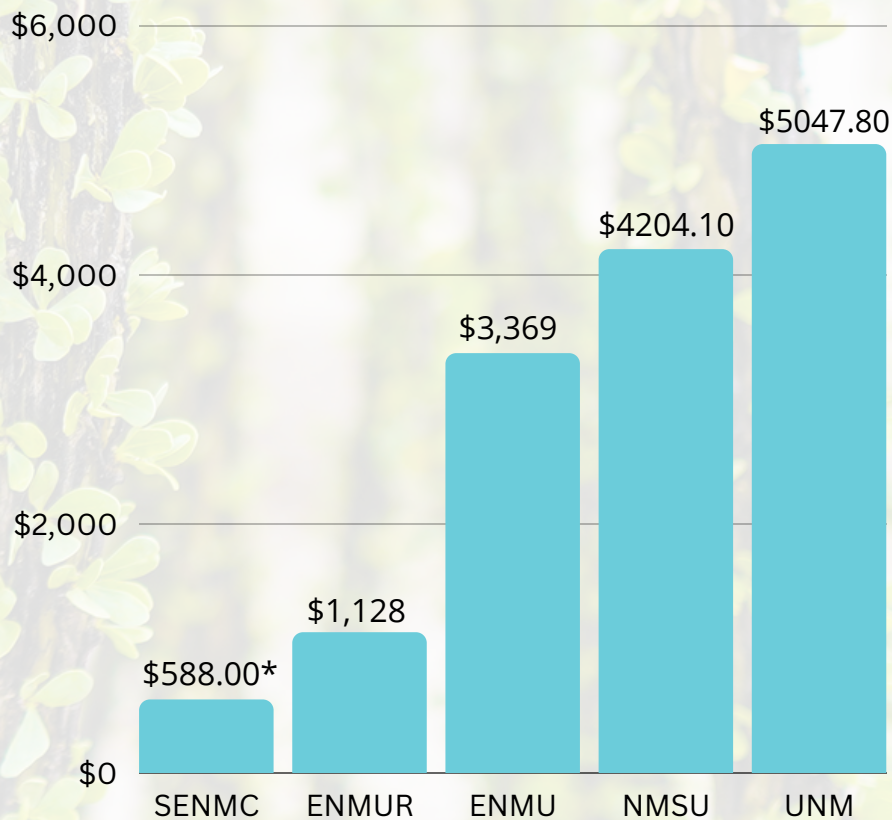
